

## IPA Releases Proposed 2025-2026 Self-direct Program Size

The Illinois Power Agency (IPA) has released its <u>proposed Large Customer Self-direct Renewable Portfolio</u> <u>Standard Compliance Program (Self-direct Program) size</u> for the 2025-2026 Program Year.

The Self-direct Program provides a means for large electric load Illinois customers (aggregated demand over 10 MW) served by ComEd or Ameren Illinois to retire Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) acquired through private long-term contracts with new utility-scale wind and/or solar facilities. Participants in the Self-direct Program receive an electric bill credit reducing Renewable Portfolio Standard-related bill charges. This process establishes the number of RECs available – the program size – for the forthcoming 2025-2026 Program Year.

The IPA seeks feedback on the proposed program size in accordance with the development process outlined in the 2024 Long-Term Plan.
