**IPA, ICC, and IEPA Seek Stakeholder Feedback

On June 16, the Illinois Power Agency (IPA), Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC), and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) held a cross-agency workshop to engage stakeholders in the upcoming Resource Adequacy Study.

The workshop provided an overview of the study's purpose, statutory mandates, timeline, and proposed methodological approach. It also outlined the scope of the modeling and analysis, clarified the roles of each Agency, and shared information on next steps in the process.
