



Illinois Power Agency Releases Draft Carbon Mitigation Credit Procurement Plan for Public Comment

September 17, 2021

Pursuant to Section 1-75(d-10) of the Illinois Power Act, as recently enacted through Public Act 102-0662, the Illinois Power Agency [has released](#) its draft Carbon Mitigation Credit Procurement Plan for public comment. As required under Public Act 102-0662, this plan sets forth the process for the procurement of carbon mitigation credits generated by at-risk nuclear plants in recognition of their carbon free attributes, and to support those plants' continued operation. As required by state law, public comments on the Carbon Mitigation Credit Procurement Plan are due by **September 24, 2021**. After receipt of public comments, the Agency will revise the Plan as warranted and file that Plan with the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) for approval. The ICC will have 42 days for its review and approval of the Carbon Mitigation Credit Procurement Plan.
