Public Notice of Winning Bidders and Average Prices

Concerning the Illinois Power Agency's April 28, 2010 Procurement of Standard Energy Products for Commonwealth Edison Company

Notice Issued: April 30, 2010

On April 28, 2010, NERA Economic Consulting ("NERA"), the Procurement Administrator retained by the Illinois Power Agency ("IPA") for the 2010 procurements for Commonwealth Edison Company ("ComEd"), received bids for the ComEd Standard Energy Products Procurement pursuant to the IPA's Procurement Plan approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. 09-0373. On April 30, 2010, the Commission voted to approve the bids recommended for approval by the Procurement Administrator. Section 16-111.5(h) of the Public Utilities Act provides that "[t]he names of the successful bidders and the load weighted average of the winning bid prices for each contract type and for each contract term shall be made available to the public at the time of Commission approval of a procurement event." 220 ILCS 5/16-111.5(h).
